

The Reading for Virginia Educators (RVE) has the strength of measuring some degree of pedagogical knowledge needed for the teaching of Reading to at least Pk-6 students. It is a VDOE licensure requirement and meets the approval of several state panels and boards. A major limitation is the lack of reliability and validity data on the RVE published by the testing company or VDOE. Another limitation is that some students take the RVE before they successfully complete the reading related courses in their teacher training programs. The faculty agrees that the RVE results should be used in conjunction with other measures to determine our program completers' degree of pedagogical knowledge in the teaching of Reading.
