The VCLA is a standardized assessment mandated for teacher licensure by the VDOE. The VCLA assesses verbal and written language skills deemed necessary to be competent teachers. The VCLA is criterion referenced and objective based and is designed to measure a candidate's knowledge and skills in relation to an established standard rather than in relation to the performance of other candidates (Pearson, 2010). Specifically, Pearson reports that for the subject of reading the assessment is designed to measure comprehension and analysis of readings, outlining and summarizing skills, and ability to interpret tables and graphs. For the subject of writing, the assessment is designed to measure the development of ideas in essay form on specific topics and the mastery of grammar, mechanics, and vocabulary (http://www.va.nesinc.com). A cut score is required to meet the licensure requirement in Virginia. If met or exceeded, it is another indicator of the skills necessary to be a competent and qualified professional educator.

The VCLA has the strength of measuring basic communication skills often taught in General Education courses, particular in English courses, therefore measuring some degree of subject matter knowledge. It is also a VDOE licensure requirement indicating the state has faith in the instrument. A major limitation is the lack of reliability and validity data on the VCLA published by the testing company or the VDOE. Another limitation is that test anxiety may play a role in how a student performs on this standardized assessment. The faculty agrees that the VCLA results should be used in conjunction with other measures to determine our program completers' degree of subject matter knowledge.
