#### **General Notes**

- Check Degree Works or the Catalog for course pre-requisite information.
- Minimum C- grade for major coursework required
- 50% of major requirements must be taken at Regent University
- A minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA is required to maintain good academic standing.
- Some majors also require a minimum grade in all major courses.
- As a general rule, 100 and 200 level courses should be taken prior to upper level (300 and 400) level courses.
- A minimum of 120 credits is required.
- > A minor may be completed in place of a portion of the general electives. Students must still earn 120 credits total.
- > Honors & on campus students will have 15 less general elective credits due to taking the C&C minor or Honors courses.

#### **Major Related Notes**

- Students in this program will learn to teach according to the Virginia Standards of Learning.
- This major leads to initial teacher licensure. See the Undergraduate Catalog, Teacher Education section, for specific requirements for application to the required professional studies courses (UED), pre-service teaching, & licensure courses.
- Licensure track Teacher Education students must earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in their Major coursework.
- ▶ UED 495 requires completion of all licensure requirements and all courses except UED 495 and UED 496.
- ➤ UED 496 is taken concurrently with UED 495.
- > Students are strongly advised to not have an additional job while taking UED 495 and UED 496.
- Courses available once a year in Fall: UIS 310, 341, 350, 360, 370, 414, and UED 400, 406, 442, 451
- Courses available once a year in Spring: UIS 201, 304, 330, 325, 412, 440, and UED 405, 408, 441
