

## Students’ Right-to-Know Cohort Completion Rates

Regent University is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation or completion rates of our full-time, first-time, bachelor’s degree-seeking undergraduates and student-athletes. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended.

As part of our compliance processes, we are to report data on those students who have completed their degrees within 150% of the typical time to do so. However, we have not yet enrolled athletic students for a long enough period of time to reach that time span. However, we are reporting the current progress towards degree completion for the Fall 2016 cohort.

During the fall semester of 2016, **266** first-time, full-time, bachelor’s degree-seeking undergraduate students entered Regent University.

*While reviewing this information, please keep in mind:*

- This report shows undergraduate enrollment numbers only. High school dual-credit/dual-enrollment and non-degree students are not included.
- We have elected not to report our transfer-out rate because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in other institutions.
- The reasons why students withdrew are not identified; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- The graduation/completion rate does not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
