

CHURCH MATCHING GRANT POLICIES & PROCEDURES

An Eternal Investment

Helping a congregation fund their college expenses is worthwhile investment. A church or church affiliated ministry contribution helps produce *Christian Leaders to Change the World!* In an effort to promote wise financial stewardship, Regent University established the *Church Matching Grant Program*. To date, more than 200 churches from various denominations have partnered with us.

Regent University matches recognized Church/Ministry contributions dollar-for dollar up to specified limits. Additionally, enrollment status will affect Church Matching Grant eligibility. Please not the following:

Enrollment Status	Regent Will Match
Full-time	100% of Church/Ministry contribution (up to \$750/semester)
½- or ¾-time	50% of Church/Ministry contribution (up to \$375/semester)
Less than ½-time	0% of Church/Ministry contribution

Church/Ministry Participation

The church or ministry should:

- 1. Identify the person to assist
- 2. Complete the attached application
- 3. Mail the church/ministry contribution with the completed application form to:

- * Send the application and contribution together to ensure funds are applied to the matching program benefit.
- 4. Make contributions via check from the Church/Ministry directly (personal checks and Electronic Fund Transfers [EFTs] are not accepted).
- 5. Make checks payable to Regent University. Enter the student's name and "Church Match" on the *For* line (if available).
- 6. Submit contribution on or before the following dates for timely processing:

Fall: August 1st Spring: December 1st Summer: April 1st

Note: It is not the intent of this program for the student or the student's parents/relatives to make a gift to the Church/Ministry and ask that the student be the recipient.

Student Qualifications & Program Limitations

The student must:

- 1. Complete the admissions process and be accepted to Regent University; and,
- 2. Enroll in an eligible degree-seeking program.

Matching awards are subject to the availability of program funds. Additionally, matched university funds may be applied toward *tuition only*. Students are responsible for any remaining account balances including, but not limited to, remaining tuition, semester fees, and housing costs. Church match funds, including the church contribution, may reduce other university-funded financial aid and/or other sources of financial aid based on pre-determined awarding rules or regulations.
