# GENERAL FORMATTING

- **Font:** 11 pt. font that is plain and easy to read, Times New Roman, Helvetica, Courier, or Garamond (p. 11)
- □ **Margins:** 1.5" inch all around (p. 11)
- □ **Pagination**: upper right hand corner. No page number should appear on the title page or the first page of the text; however, the title page is considered page 1 (p. 11)
- Character Spacing: one space after <u>final punctuation of a sentence</u> (p. 16)

#### TITLE PAGE

- **Content:** On separate lines include: title of paper, the author's name, and college or university. Center all lines (p. 11)
- **Title:** Should be descriptive but no more than 12 words in length (p. 10)

#### ABSTRACT

- **Title:** center "Abstract" near the top of the paper and bold; underneath this, center the title of the paper (p. 11)
- Paragraph: not indented; one paragraph only! (p. 11)
- □ Word Limit: no more than 150 words
- **Purpose:** precisely states the paper's topic, research and analysis methods, and results and conclusions (p. 11)

#### BODY

□ **Headings**: <u>Primary</u>: **bold**, centered; <u>Secondary</u>: **bold**, flush left; <u>Tertiary</u>: <u>Underlined</u>, flush left and followed immediately by a period and then the first line of your text. All 3 use headline style capitalization (p. 12)

## CITATIONS (FOOTNOTES)

- Citation from a book, 1 author: (Last name year, #) (Smith 2018, 21) (p. 17, 19)
- Citations from a book, 2 authors: (Last name 1 and Last name 2 year, #) (Smith and Jones 2013, 54) (p. 17-18)
- □ **Block quotes:** (for direct quotes of +5 lines) indent ½" on left; no quotation marks; final punctuation goes before intext citation, which should appear at the end of the block quote with no punctuation after (p. 711-12, CMS)

## **REFERENCE PAGE**

- □ **Indent**: Hanging, ½″ (p. 24)
- □ **Title**: References (centered, bolded) (p. 24)
- Order: Alphabetical by author; use title of work if same author (p. 24)
- □ **Spacing:** Everything double-spaced (including references themselves) (p. 24)
- **Titles:** Use headline style capitalization (p. 25)
- □ **Italics**: Titles of books and journals (p. 25-26)
- Classical Texts: Bible does not appear in Bibliography (p. 27-28)
- Reference Entry for book: Last name, First name. Year. *Title*. Place of publication: Publisher. (p. 24)
- Reference Entry for Journal: Last name, First name. Year. "Title." *Journal Name*. Volume #. (Month): page numbers. Hunzecker, Joan. 2004. "Teaching the Toadies: Cronyism in Municipal Politics." *Review of Local Politics* 4 (June): 250-62. (p. 26)
