₃ Students are required to begin registering for dissertation credits immediately following the successful completion of all req. courses.

Ph.D. students must register for a <u>minimum of 12 credit hours</u> of dissertation research. If the student does not complete the dissertation in the required 12 credits, they will enroll for BPHD 794 Dissertation Continuation (1) each semester until the dissertation is successfully completed and defended.

Students who cannot finish the editing phase in the same term as

BPHD 793, must register for BPHD 795 Dissertation Editing Course.
