## General Notes

> Check Degree Works or the Catalog for course pre-requisite information.
> Minimum C- grade for major coursework required
> 50\% of major requirements must be taken at Regent University
$>$ A minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA is required to maintain good academic standing.
> Some majors also require a minimum grade in all major courses.
> As a general rule, 100 and 200 level courses should be taken prior to upper level ( 300 and 400 ) level courses.
$>$ A minimum of 123 credits is required.
> A minor may be completed in place of a portion of the general electives. Students must still earn 123 credits total.
$>$ Honors \& on campus students will have 15 less general elective credits due to taking the C\&C minor or Honors courses.
> Transfer or PLA credits may not be used for MUSC courses.
> Students may take a placement assessment before coursework, and with department permission may substitute additional MUSC 348 for one credit from MUSC 125, 135, 145 or 155.
